A LABAMA happrenings

PELHAM CHURCH OF GOD

On January 8, 2023, members of the Pelham Church of God, along with guests and friends, including Dr. Raymond C. and Peggy Culpepper, First Assistant General Overseer of the Church of God, and Mildred Lanier, Pelham City Councilwoman, celebrated ninety years of ministry to the Shelby County community.

During the service, with the help of former pastor's wife, Annette Massey, and Councilwoman Lanier, Dr. Culpepper lit the mortgage as Pastor Michael Welborn held it up for everyone to see. The mortgage burning ceremony commemorated the final payment being paid by a miraculous gift in July 2022.

Also, as part of the celebration, an Open House unveiled the new office complex for Pelham Church Ministries. The 3,000 square feet office suite, constructed by Lindsey Construction Company, includes a reception area, copy room, six offices, restroom, and conference area.

The church began in the early 1930s when a group of people began a prayer meeting in an old building in Helena. After three months, the group decided to worship in a brush arbor and the Pelham Church of God was chartered on January 1, 1933, with eight members. A half-acre piece of land was donated, and the first church was built and deeded in the early 1940s. Rev. O.C. Kendrick was the first pastor. Later, a piece of property was purchased on Highway 31, and a concrete block church was built. In the early 1960s, a new church was constructed behind the old concrete building. In July of 1990, the church purchased the Butler Building on Highway 52 in Pelham, Alabama which housed a ceramic shop. The building was renovated, housing the sanctuary and a parsonage for the pastor. In the late 1990s, the present sanctuary was constructed.

Over the years, twenty-nine pastors have served the Pelham Church of God. The church came from humble brush arbor beginnings and continues to be strong through the power of the Holy Spirit for the glory of God.









DESTINATION CHURCH: UGANDA

Destination Church launched its first international campus in Uganda in February 2023 with a stunning turnout of 900 members on its inaugural service. The launch of the Uganda campus is a significant milestone for Destination Church, which has rapidly expanded its reach across the Gulf Coast. The church has already established successful outreaches locally and now internationally.

The new campus, located in the city of Kabwohe, was filled with energetic music and passionate preaching. The campus has been open daily, with worship services led by campus Pastor Collins since the launch.

The beginning of this journey all started with the church's partnership with Nassan Ibrahim who serves as a Bishop in Uganda.

"We are so excited to be launching this new campus in Uganda," said Pastor Wayne Sheppard, who leads Destination Church. "We launched House of Hope orphanage there in 2022 and felt this was the next step in reaching more people for the Kingdom." "House of Hope houses 280 plus orphans and is one of our church's greatest accomplishments".

Pastor Collins, the campus Pastor at Destination Church Uganda, has shared that they have church every day with around 1000 people. Saraland is donating to the campus four cows for their upcoming Easter celebration. In June, DC Saraland is sending an outreach missions team to work at House of Hope and visit our Uganda Campus.







CATHEDRAL OF PRAISE CHURCH OF GOD

It is a glorious time for the church! As the spirit of the antichrist is perverting so much in society and glorifying wickedness, God has risen in His people who have been hungry and thirsty for His presence. On February 24, 2023, on the opening night of what was to be a weekend revival at the Cathedral of Praise COG (formerly Alabama City COG) located in Gadsden, Alabama, the glory of God powerfully entered the sanctuary. Evangelist Garrett Marchant from Gastonia, North Carolina, brought a timely word for that opening service—"The Devil Is A Lie." At this writing, we are moving into our fourth week of revival, and we believe God has transitioned this revival into a movement! What is happening at Cathedral of Praise has been nothing short of God's goodness, mercy, love, and fulfillment of His promise to His people.
