SUBJECT: "Let's Go Girls" Girls Day Out - April 20, 2024

It is so hard to fathom that this is my final GDO in Alabama as the GM Coordinator. It's my "Last Rodeo", so let's make it the BEST! The date is **Saturday**, **April 20**, **2024**, and <u>ALL GIRLS</u> ages 3-18 are invited. The theme is **Let's Go Girls** and our theme verse is, Mark 16:15 "He said to them, 'Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation...'". It's time that we rise up and tell all creation about Him. There is no time to spare! The fees are \$20.00 per person if registration is postmarked by the EARLY-BIRD deadline of March 21, 2024, Regular- \$25 March 22-April 4, Late- \$30 April 5-17 and Walk-On- \$35 after April 17, 2024.

Cabins will be available for an additional \$10/person (mark this on registration form) for those desiring to come Friday night. This year we will have Pizza to go along with our devotion time. GDO will not officially begin until Saturday morning, so plan breakfast accordingly. We will have a Devotion, Pizza, Bonfire and Fellowship Friday night @ 7:00pm. You're welcome to sit out mingling before then! We'd love to have your girls ministries join us for this time of fellowship! Remember to bring your own chair or towel/blanket to sit on! Deadline to register to stay the night will be 4.17.24.

Liability Release Forms are required for all girls and adult attendees. These should be brought with you to registration.

Lots of great activities are being planned. See the FAQ Sheet for all activities and details. Also, in an effort to serve others, all groups will be given an opportunity to bring a gift card (see separate guidelines) for Alabama Ministers' Widows, as well as give to our YWEA & Kids On A Mission project, Australia, Fiji, New Zealand – "Restoring Hope, Reclaiming Lives". We have coin folders and brochures if you would like to use these to promote YWEA for this mission. To help support our Covenant Sisters, you are able to send that offering in with your registration for your church to get credit, or bring the offering that day. Covenant Sisters make up those regions in the Church of God that are not self-supportive (mission or financially challenged regions) and are unable to have events without our help. We are so blessed in Alabama to have the ability to experience amazing events such as GDO. I'm excited to say we will have a GM t-shirt on preorder basis only! The shirts will be \$15! Deadline is 4.4.24.

At the end of the day, we will have door prizes to give away and some special gifts given out. We will also have prizes for the churches that have Girls Clubs and have won in their category located on a table for them to pick up. If you do an organized club, please make sure to fill out the award forms for credit!
