CAMP UTOPIA

Development Update

We have anticipated the build at Camp Utopia not only since the groundbreaking in October 2022, but it's been a dream of many for years. As the construction comes to completion in the building process, we anticipate great memories to be made by the staff and guests who will enter the structure's doors.

This 30x60 floor plan has eleven bedrooms, nine queen rooms, one of which is an ADA-compliant room, and two double bunk rooms. Each of these rooms has a private bathroom. There is a common area with a place to sit and relax and a small area with café-style tables where you can eat, play games, and take time to read or sit and talk. A kitchenette houses a coffee pot, microwave, and refrigerator for the guests and staff.
