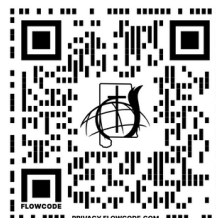

Alabama Camp Meeting 2025
Metropolitan Church, Birmingham



In early June, the Alabama Church of God family gathered at Metropolitan Church of God in Birmingham for a powerful week of worship, renewal, and connection. Under the theme *Unshakable*, the 2025 Camp Meeting called believers to stand firm in faith and remain rooted in Christ through every season.

From June 3–6, the sanctuary was filled with heartfelt worship and Spirit-led preaching. Guest speakers Tolan Morgan, Jason Daughdrill, Wayne Dority, Tony Suarez, Jennifer Porter-Cox, Alton Bristow, and Caleb Crooms each brought inspiring messages that stirred hearts and strengthened the body of Christ. Worship throughout the week created an atmosphere of unity and expectancy as generations came together to encounter God's presence and celebrate His faithfulness.

Beyond the pulpit, the week featured meaningful moments that highlighted the heart of the Alabama Church of God. A touching Memorial Tribute honored those who have gone on to be with the Lord, and a recognition service celebrated newly retired ministers for their faithful years of service.

The Glow with Grace Gathering brought widows and Guardian Sisters together for encouragement and fellowship, while World Missions presentations reminded attendees of the church's ongoing commitment to reach the nations.

A spirit of commissioning filled the atmosphere during the Bishop Ordination and the MIP and CAMS graduation ceremonies, as new ministers were prayed over and sent into the harvest. The Youth Mass Choir added vibrant energy and passion, leading worship that reflected the strength and enthusiasm of the next generation.

As the final service concluded, the message of the week remained clear: being unshakable doesn't mean life is without challenges—it means our foundation in Christ will never fail. The Alabama Church of God left Birmingham strengthened, inspired, and ready to live *Unshakable* in every season, carrying the momentum of Camp Meeting into the months ahead.

What an unforgettable summer it was at Redemption Alabama Youth Camp 2025! Over the course of four powerful weeks, more than 1,850 students and staff stepped away from the noise of everyday life and into a life-changing encounter with Jesus Christ.

Each day was packed with the best of camp life—team competitions that brought out everyone’s spirit, late-night laughter echoing through the dorms, energetic worship that filled the air, and friendships that will last a lifetime. But beyond the fun and fellowship, the eternal impact is what truly defines this season. Countless campers made first-time decisions to follow Christ, many were baptized in the Holy Spirit, and hearts were healed, restored, and called into ministry. God moved in miraculous ways, and the testimonies continue to pour in—stories of transformation that will shape a generation.

This year’s camp wasn’t only about personal encounters; it was also about collective compassion. Our students united for a global cause, raising \$10,479.30 for Orphan Run 4 Hope and \$3,468.53 for YWEA. Their generosity will reach across borders, sowing seeds of love and hope in the lives of children around the world. What a powerful reminder that when students catch the heart of God, their impact knows no limits.

Behind every victory and breakthrough was a team of faithful volunteers who gave their all. From cabin leaders and kitchen teams to recreation staff and administrators, each person played a vital role in creating a space where students could meet God in a fresh and personal way. Their dedication and servant hearts made Redemption Youth Camp more than just a program—it became a place of purpose, transformation, and calling.

Our hearts are full and our faith is expectant for what’s ahead. Plans are already underway for next year’s camp season, set for summer 2026, and the excitement is building around the new theme: “Ready to Play.”

The world may be virtual—but the Truth is still reality. Next summer, students will dive deep into a world of screens, static, and distraction to rediscover what is real. Jesus is the Reality that never glitches. Identity is more than a username. And Truth still breaks through the static.
